Hamerton – A Silent Soldier will be in the village to give an opportunity for prayer and reflection. War graves will be lit Saturday evening and Hamerton will also take part in ‘Ringing Remembers’ and there will be 100 bells rung on **Remembrance Sunday**.

Upton – Saturday 10th November - lighting up of the War Graves in the Churchyard. Prayer and Reflection in the church at 4pm followed by going outside to light up the graves
